A MESSAGE FROM THE QUEEN

To the citizens of the United States of America from Her Sovereign Majesty Queen Elizabeth II of Great Britain.

In light of your displeasure in selecting the current President of the United Sates of America, Donald Trump and thus to govern yourselves, we hereby give notice of the Revocation of your Independence, effective immediately. (You should look up 'revocation' in the Oxford English Dictionary.)
